**Murder My Sweet (1945) Dick Powell, Claire Trevor, Anne Shirley (1hr 35min)**

Philip Marlowe is hired to accompany a playboy buying back some jewels. When the exchange results in the playboy's murder, Marlowe can't leave the case alone. As he gets drawn deeper into a complex web of intrigue by a mysterious blonde, the detective finds his own life in increasing jeopardy.

Overwhelmed by her schedule, European princess, Ann, takes off for a night in Rome. When a sedative she took from her doctor kicks in, she falls asleep on a park bench and is found by an American reporter who takes her back to his apartment for safety. At work the next morning, Joe finds out Ann's identity and bets his editor he can get an exclusive interview with her, but romance soon gets in the way.

**Hang 'Em High (1968) Clint Eastwood, Inger Stevens, Ed Begley (1h 56min)**

After a gang of men attempts to kill him for a crime he did not commit, Jed Cooper is saved by a marshal and a judge. The lawmen offer him a job as a marshal with the rule that he not abuse his new power to seek revenge. But, when Cooper finds that some of the men who attacked him are involved in another set of crimes, he fights to bring them to justice.
